WINTER WEATHER POLICY REMINDER



Now that winter has officially arrived in the form of snow, this will be a good time to go over our Winter Weather Policy. The full policy can be found on the Council

bulletin board in the narthex, as well as on our <u>BLC</u> <u>website</u>. In summary it states: "If Portage Public Schools are closed or dismissed early due to inclement weather, the church office will be closed, and all church activities, **except worship**, will be cancelled for the day and that evening. If there is a delayed start, the church office may be closed until staff can safely travel. Notifications will always be posted on the BLC website and Facebook page and when called for an email and text (for those that have opted in for text messaging) will be sent out to those involved in the activities.

For Worship services: "If Portage is under a Winter Storm Warning, and many other area churches are

cancelling their services, a decision to cancel worship service will be made 2 hours prior to the start of worship. If Sunday worship is cancelled, Sunday School will also be cancelled." If worship is cancelled, it will be posted in the following places:
