

#### COVID TASK FORCE UPDATES

After prayerful consideration, the Covid Task Force will be loosening restrictions while still following CDC guidelines around worship and gatherings.

- <u>Masks</u>: masks are not required for those who are vaccinated. Masks are recommended for anyone not fully vaccinated.
- <u>Food/eating</u>: food can be served and eaten indoors while following safe food handling procedures.
- <u>Singing</u>: congregational singing will be allowed starting immediately.
- <u>Communion</u>: starting July 4<sup>th</sup>, you will have a choice in how you would like to receive communion. We will continue to offer the prepacked elements which you can either pick up on your way into the sanctuary or come up to the altar to receive them. You will also have the choice to come to the altar to receive communion in the traditional way.
- <u>Classrooms</u>: Sunday School classrooms can now be used.

Even though we are basically back to "pre-Covid normal", we still want everyone to exercise caution as the virus is till out there and not everyone is vaccinated. A reminder, if you are not feeling well, stay home. If you have a cold/flu symptoms, wearing a mask is a good idea to protect others and yourself as cold/flu season starts. Please continue to wash/sanitize your hands before and after being around others and eating. Let's all do our part to keep everyone healthy.

# 🏲 Call Committee Update

Over the past two months, the committee has been working on reviewing candidate information and conducting interviews. Three candidates during this time were presented by the Synod, two were interviewed via a Zoom meeting and the call committee then requested a second interview with one of the candidates. The second interview was a face-to-face meeting that took place in May. After this meeting, the entire committee was extremely impressed feeling that the candidate would be a particularly good fit for our congregation. The committee then began the plans for initiating a call to the candidate through the Synod and church council. However, when the candidate was recontacted days later, we found out that they had accepted another call. While this news was disheartening to the committee, we are prayerfully moving ahead and waiting for the synod to send additional candidate information for continuing review. Again, we will keep you informed on interviews and progress in the pastoral call!

Review of Call Committee Timeline since October 2020: A Ministry Site Profile for Bethlehem was created from responses to the congregational survey completed in December 2020. The MSP was then submitted to the council and the Synod and approved. The MSP expresses information for finding a matching relationship with our congregation and a new pastor.

Considering the many factors from the survey and MSP, this led to the committee decision (from the congregation's input) that we would be seeking a new pastor this year. Pastor Jen has done wonderful work as a renewal pastor for the past two and half years and we have greatly appreciated her efforts especially during the disruptions in life the pandemic continues to put

forth. Pastor Jen's ministry efforts for our congregation continue until July of this year and we are grateful for her service.

The Call Committee's goal is to have good communication with congregation members of Bethlehem throughout the call process. We will strive for frequent communication to you via announcement updates, the Chimes, the church website, etc. The pastoral call is not simply the committee's decision. We are reaching out to members of Bethlehem of all ages to help and guide us as we determine a profile for our church life and find the optimum fit for a pastor we will call.
